VISION & MISSION

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



- **Need:** No single institute offers within the ADAMS vicinity, such a comprehensive after school program for young Muslims at an affordable financial cost . (See Appendix for survey results.)
 - Satisfies private and home school parents need to augment their child's "book knowledge" education
- **Financial Cost:** Services provided at an affordable cost under a comprehensive umbrella program.
 - Also available in ala carte basis
 - "One stop shop"
- **Family Scheduling:** With weekends filled with other activities, this program offers the opportunity for more family activities during weekdays. Children can participate in this program while parents can attend the Qurtuba Institute programs.



THE PROGRAM



Program Curriculum:

- Quran, Islamic and Arabic Studies
- Sports (Example: Martial Arts, Basketball, Volley Ball etc.)
- Activities (Example: Cooking, Gardening, Robotics, computers...)
- Optionally available Tutoring (English, Math, and Science)

Different Scenarios of Need:

- Student A enrolls in Islamic studies Track and other activities
- Student B enrolls in Arabic Studies Track and other activities
- Both Students Will learn Quran in each Track
- Arabic Studies' teaching medium is strictly Arabic Language
- Islamic Studies track is taught in English Language (Quran in Arabic)



CURRICULUM



Students will be divided into two groups (not to exceed 15 students in each class)
based on grade level:

- Young Group – 2nd -5th
- Youth Group – 6th -10th

Quranic Study: Two Levels for Each Group

- ✦ Level 1 - Basic Reading
- ✦ Level 2 - Advance Reading & Basic Tajweed

Islamic Study: Based on Grade Level

- ✦ Young 2nd - 5th: Basic Aqeeda & Akhlaq I
- ✦ Youth 5th - 10th: Basic Aqeeda, Akhlaq II & Tafseer

- Young 2nd - 5th
Uhibbu al-Arabiyya Level I
- Youth 5th - 10th
Uhibbu al- Arabiyya Level II

Sports

- Martial Arts (Youth Group)
- Basketball (Young & Youth group)
- Soccer (Spring & Fall Seasons)
- Volleyball (Young & Youth groups)

Optional Tutoring

- English
- Math
- Science

STAFFING



The following staff is required to run the program effectively:

- **Administrator:** To manage the program, supervise activities and assist teachers, students, and parents.
- **Quran Teacher:** Requires at least one experienced Quran teacher.
- **Arabic Teacher:** Requires at least one experienced Arabic teacher.
- **Islamic Studies Teacher:** Requires at least one experienced Islamic Studies teacher.
- **Teacher's Assistant:** Requires three assistant, one for each area of study.
- **Volunteers:** Each Activity and sports event will require multiple volunteers (Please Sign-up if you are interested)
