ADAMS TAHFEEDH UL QURAN PROGRAM

PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS:

After the student completes the required assessments, teachers and staff will discuss the assessment results, recommendation letters and the overall information about the child (behavior, abilities, focus level, motivation and family support) to determine if the child meets eligibility requirements to join the program.

If a child meets the eligibility requirements, the Tahfeedh ul Quran Program will send an acceptance email to the family. The family has a choice to accept or decline to enroll the student in the program.

The Tahfeedh ul Quran Program school year begins from September to August (specific start and end date will be provided). The family must submit post-dated checks and required documents for the above months by June to complete the child's registration and secure a seat in class.

All students are enrolled in the Hifdh Preparation Class for 1 year. Objectives and expectations from students will be provided for the Hifdh Preparation Class. Upon successful completion of the Hifdh Preparation Class, the student will be recommended to continue memorization in the Tahfeedh ul Quran Program. Teacher will provide a specific month by month memorization plan for the child based on the child's abilities, efforts, motivation, family support and overall disposition.

A child's progress will be monitored month by month. If a child is not showing progress due to frequent absences, tardies, lack of motivation, lack of efforts, lack of parent support and involvement with child's homework expectations, un-satisfactory performance on hifdh tests or unable to bear the work-load to maintain and apply tajweed with reviews and daily work), the family will be informed immediately. Parent/teacher meetings will be held and specific changes/progress must be shown by student in order to continue in the program.
