Step 1:

- Please set up an appointment to schedule a Quran Reading Assessment for your child.
 - Email - tahfeez-quran@adamscenter.org
 - Include First and Last Name of Child - First and Last Name of Parents / Phone Number
 - Date of Birth
 - Grade Level
 - Indicate if your child has completed the Noorani Qaidah and the name of the teacher
 - Indicate if your child reads independently from Quran
 - Indicate how many surahs/juz your child memorized
 - Name of Previous/Current Quran Teacher and Contact Number/Email
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- Your child will be scheduled for an assessment and you will receive feedback whether your child is a candidate for joining classes in the Tahfeedh ul Quran Program. Typically, students will be scheduled for at least 2 assessments by staff.
 - You will receive a Registration Form on the day of the first assessment. Please submit registration form and bring a registration fee \$75 check payable to ADAMS Tahfeez.
 - If your child meets the eligibility requirements (Quran reading, focus level, academic, emotional and behavior criteria), and if there is space in the class, you will be notified & further appointments will be scheduled to discuss details of the program, enrollment & placement.
 - If your child does not meet the eligibility requirements, you will be provided resources/tutors and classes to assist your child improve the weak areas. Program staff will keep monitoring the progress frequently and provide feedback.
 - All new students are placed in the Hifdh Preparation Class. This class is designed to provide an opportunity for the student to experience the Quran Memorization process. It will provide parents an opportunity to get first hand experience of what is expected from parents in regards to time, efforts and support on a daily basis. to help their child have a successful hifdh journey. Additionally, it will provide useful information for teachers/staff to know whether the child has the academic abilities, efforts to study, focus level, to concentrate on details and overall motivation, emotional and behavior disposition.
 - Hifdh Preparation Class : Students learn the value of the Quran, the purpose of memorizing the Quran, and the importance of learning and reciting the Quran with tajweed rules. Students learn the responsibilities and rewards of those who memorize and most importantly ways to improving their love and connection to Allah and Quran. Additionally, refine pronunciation of letters, improve reading accuracy and flow, learn tajweed rules in theory and application, Students are required to read the meanings upon receiving new memorization and increase Quranic Vocabulary. The class consists of individualized time with teacher, group learning and individual practice time. Students are required at a minimum to complete memorization of juz 30 & juz 29 with tajweed application. Additionally, students receive practical help to develop effective study habits, improve time management skills, manners of listening and correcting recitations of Quran by peers and learn short term and long goal-setting. Parents will receive comprehensive daily reports and scheduled progress reports. Parents will be notified if the child is a candidate to continue in program and a monthly plan will be made to monitor progress. Students who are not eligible to continue will receive recommendations to enroll in evening /weekend Quran Classes or receive private tutoring at home.
