The additional notes below are to help you benefit from the Khutbah.

“In the name of Allah, the Beneficent, Most Merciful”

We begin in the name of Allah, the Beneficent, the Merciful. Glory be to His hallowed name. “The Most Merciful. It is He Who taught the Qur’an, created humans, and taught them expression through speech.” (55:1-4) As the poet says:

While we give praise to the Most Merciful for His unending Mercy upon us, we, in turn, must seek His Mercy by being merciful. The Prophet Muhammad (SAW) commanded us: “The merciful are shown mercy by the Most Merciful. Be merciful on the earth, and you will be shown mercy from Who is above the heavens.” (Tirmidhi) We seek the mercy of the Most Merciful by showing mercy to our children, spouses, parents, and friends. Just as we raise our hands to seek His mercy, so too should we open our hearts for others.
